## INCIDENT PROCEDURES

The expectations for good behavior during FGSC are the same as the expectations held during the school day/year. In addition, student cell phones may not be used during camp. Program staff may confiscate a cell phone if a camper refuses to turn it off and put it away.

The goal of FGSC is to provide fun, educational and recreational activities for students. For the benefit and safety of ALL campers and staff, it is important that campers behave appropriately while attending. If it becomes necessary to take disciplinary actions against a camper, the following steps will be carried out:

**1<sup>st</sup> Incident:** The camper will receive a verbal warning and a one-on-one explanation as to why the behavior is inappropriate. The camper's parent/guardian will be contacted of the incident.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Incident:** Staff will determine an appropriate consequence for the camper's action (i.e., exclusion from a particular activity). The camper's parent/guardian will be notified of the incident.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Incident:** The camper will be excused from camp. The parent/guardian will be notified of the decision.

### **NOTE:**

Depending upon the severity, FGSC reserves the right to bar ANY child from camp following a first incident. Serious offenses include but are not restricted to fighting, weapon possession, inappropriate or dangerous bus behavior, or other behaviors outlined in the SDOL Standards and Expectations of Behavior for Students. Again, these types of behaviors may result in immediate dismissal from the program.

# BUS BEHAVIOR STANDARDS

Future Generations Summer Camp's goal is to keep me and other campers safe when taking trips. Therefore, I will adhere to the following Bus Behavior Standards for the Future Generations Summer Camp 2010:

- ✓ I will board and exit the bus in a safe and orderly manner.
- ✓ I will not push while boarding or exiting the bus.
- ✓ I will remain seated while on the bus.
- ✓ I will talk with other campers using an inside voice.
- ✓ I will keep all parts of my body inside of the bus windows.
- ✓ I will keep aisles free from obstruction.
- ✓ I will treat the driver, counselors and other campers with respect.
- ✓ I will treat the bus with care.
- ✓ I will use earphones when using electronic equipment.
- ✓ I will not tamper with bus controls or emergency equipment.
- ✓ I will not put objects out of the window or hang out of the windows.
- ✓ I will not engage in horseplay.
- ✓ I will not eat, drink or litter on the bus.
- ✓ I will not harass or interfere with other campers.
- ✓ I will not throw or shoot objects inside or out of the bus.
- ✓ I will not use profane or abusive language or make obscene gestures.

I have read the Bus Behavior Policy and I understand it. I also understand if I violate any of the above rules, I can be assigned to a seat where I will be kept under close supervision.
