



DISPOSE OF YOUR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS SAFELY

Prescription drug abuse causes more deaths than all illegal street drugs combined. Throwing your prescription drugs in the trash or flushing them down the toilet can harm groundwater, rivers and wildlife.

Lancaster County provides drop-off locations to make it easy to properly dispose of unused prescription medications.

WE ACCEPT:

- Prescription and over-the-counter solid medications
- Tablets and capsules
- Pet medicines

WE DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Intravenous solutions
- Injectables, syringes, and needles
- Hydrogen peroxide
- Compressed cylinders or aerosols (e.g., asthma inhalers)
- Iodine-containing medications
- Thermometers
- Alcohol & illicit drugs (i.e. marijuana, heroin, LSD, etc.)

BEFORE YOU DROP-OFF, PLEASE NOTE:

- All drugs should be placed in a sealed container such as the original bottle or a zip-lock bag.
- Keep liquids in the original container.
- Personal information should be removed or blotted out with a permanent marker.
