divorcing parents, and through the difficult loss of her brother to a rare disease. "My home life was tumultuous," Sue said. "For a while, I was homeless and lived in a camper at a gas station." In the face of that struggle, Sue and her fellow Freedom Writers went on to make an impact in creating change through their personal testimonies.
