Reducing Covid-19 Adversity for Kids:

<u>Prevention Programming:</u> Compass Mark is still working to provide support to kids during this time. As schedules and priorities are shifting, so have the ways we are offering prevention programs to students. Check them out below!

- Our YouTube channel now features several playlists which include lessons for early learners (Pre-K to 1st grade), 2nd grade, Leaders of Future Generations (grades 3, 4 & 5) and 6th grade. - Small Groups: Our Facilitators can host and facilitate Social/Emotional learning sessions with groups of kids LIVE in private, password protected Zoom rooms. This is a great option to supplement online academic programming, establish an option for additional support to kids, or to provide a 'gathering place' for groups of youth who may have met regularly pre-COVID (Scouting organizations, Youth Groups, School Clubs, Etc.)

Addiction Education for Youth & Young Adults:

One of our most well-known programs, Skills for Life, is still being held in the virtual setting and taking registrations. This award-winning program provides addiction education, resiliency skills, and an opportunity for supportive exploration of substance use on an individual's life. Targeted to those making risky choices, this program can be assigned as part of a restorative justice program or out of concern for a positive attitude toward substance use. Children/Youth with Incarcerated Parents

Our Family Services Advocates provide case management in Lancaster and Lebanon Counties to support children and the caregivers of children with parents in prison. Groups are available for the children to receive direct support and process their feelings as well as build skills such as coping, personal safety, and resilience. The Student Assistance Program has supported students in Pennsylvania for over 30 years. A partnership between schools and families, the program works to eliminate any identified barrier to a student's academic success. Any person - a neighbor, family member, teacher, or peer - can refer a student to SAP where the presenting observations will be evaluated by a trained team.
