

2021 PA Youth Survey for Chester County

Alcohol and Other Drug Trends

The following tables provide data on youth use of alcohol and other drugs. State and county data were collected via the 2021 Pennsylvania Youth Survey (PAYS) for 6th, 8th, 10th, and 12th graders. Chester County, PA participation included 44 out of 54 schools in 14 out of 16 school districts: 17,477 valid surveys total.

National comparison data is drawn from the <u>2021 Monitoring the Future Survey</u>, conducted annually on a nation-wide basis by the Survey Research Center at the University of Michigan.
