

Lancaster County Drug & Alcohol Commission Recovery House Scholarships

The Lancaster County Drug and Alcohol Commission (LCDAC) is offering <u>scholarships</u> for people in recovery from an opioid use disorder who have lived in Lancaster County for a minimum of two months. This program is funded by the Lancaster Opioid Settlement grant and applies only to <u>state-licensed</u> recovery houses.
