The Lancaster County Drug and Alcohol Commission (LCDAC) is offering [scholarships](#) for people in recovery from an opioid use disorder who have lived in Lancaster County for a minimum of two months. This program is funded by the Lancaster Opioid Settlement grant and applies only to [state-licensed](#) recovery houses.
